L-72 The Spirit's here. Anybody that wants to be saved, you can be saved right now. Anybody that wants to be healed, you can be healed right now. Do you believe it?

How many believes that? Raise your hands. You believe that God is present to heal? Now, thank you. Then you listen to me just a minute.

Jesus Christ is here and will make every person in the building well, if you'll believe it right now. If you'll accept it right now and say, "Lord, I now accept it as my personal property; I know I have the Holy Spirit; I'm into Your Kingdom here; I'm in Your great variety store, and I have a right for healing, and I'm just going to walk over here, step up on the ladder, and climb up and take it off, and come on down and then ain't nobody going to tell me nothing about it, because Jesus Christ has done brought me in here and said all these things was mine." That's right.

The devil will stand out the window and say, "Hey, you can't do that."

Say, "You can't? Watch me." Amen. That's right. "See if I don't."

Say, "Now, you better not testify you're healed before you feel something." Feel something? Brother, I believe something. I believe what God said is the truth, don't you?

L-73 I believe that His Spirit is right here over this audience. Frankly, I know it is. Now look, I could call a prayer line here and take another hour, two hours, if I could stand it, and bring every person one by one by here. Your life, sins or whatever it might be, could not be hid. You know that.

But you don't have to do that. If you'll just have faith in God, God will heal you right where you're at. Don't you believe that?

Watch. Look this way, everybody. I challenge your faith. I challenge you to believe Jesus Christ. I challenge you to take that Word that He's just the same yesterday, today, and forever, and believe it with all your heart. Do you do it? [\[Mark 11:22\]](#)

L-74 If you'll do it and be reverent and sincere in doing so, God Almighty will make you well. You believe that, everywhere? Amen.

Now, just get quiet now before Him and watch. Let's love Him. The Word has went forth. Now, the Spirit of God is in the meeting. It's been in the meeting. Now, after preaching, He will come here and if I've told the truth, He will vindicate the truth.

L-75 Now, if we called a couple people up here at the platform, you'd see in a few minutes, maybe the Lord would go to speaking, telling the people. I don't believe you have to do that. I don't believe you have to have anybody up here. I believe if you'll believe it right out there where you're at now, God will do it right where you're setting.

You believe it? Pray. Ask God and be sincere. And see if God don't do it. God--God's under obligation to do it. Now, you pray. Let's just shut ourselves in now with God. Let all the outside world be gone.

L-76 I'd say, "Lord, I believe Your Word. I believe every Word of it. And I'm now accepting It as my personal property." How many's doing that in your heart right now? Say, "I'm doing it, Lord. I'm accepting as my personal property."

I want you to be in prayer. And just look this way if you can, just be praying, saying, "Lord, give me a touch of Your blessings. Help me, O eternal God, to be Thy servant." And just let the Holy Spirit move... God, be merciful. Just look around this audience. Everybody in dead silence. I know the Lord is here.

Do you believe, setting there with your tie loosened up, sir? You believe with all your heart? With your hand... Yes. 'Course, I see you got a trumpet in your ear, haven't you? Got deaf ear. I can see that. Yes, uh-huh, you got deafness in your ear.

L-77 You also have another trouble, don't you? besides that. You got cancer, cancer in the stomach, is that right? Cancer in your stomach... Will you accept Jesus Christ right now, as your Healer? You believe it? Yes, I know. I was trying to get him... his attention. If I can get him just right, that deafness will leave him. I wanted you to see, it can be done before he comes here at the platform. See? Now, it's his individual faith. It's not mine; it's his.

Now, I see what's happening. The man's going to die, sure as the world. He's got a cancer right in the pit of his stomach. He's got trumpets, you can see them in his ears.

Now, young man, you setting by him, do you know him? Talk to him and tell him to accept Jesus Christ as his personal Saviour, he can take the trumpets out of his ears then. He will stand up and testify. Now, you be talking to him now. Tell him, say, "Believe Jesus Christ. Accept Him." And he can be healed. Amen.

Somebody else believe.

L-78 You believe with all your heart, mister? That's your wife setting by you, isn't it? Uh-huh. Yes, you've been healed before. You had something wrong on a breast or something. Is that right? And you got a throat trouble now. Is that right? You and your husband both put your hands around one another and pray. Jesus Christ will make you well.

Colored lady, just wiped your face there, you believe me to be God's servant? The little lady fanning with the... You believe with all your heart? You do? Believe God will heal you, make you well? Female trouble. But Jesus Christ can heal you, if you'll believe it. If you'll--if you'll ask Him, have faith in Him, He will do it.

Do you believe it? All right. God bless you. I want you to start praying. Some of the rest of you believe, somewhere.

L-79 Setting there on the front seats, you believe? Is that your husband setting next to you there? You believe me to be God's prophet, or His servant? I got a bawling out today, for somebody telling me, I-I announce myself as being a prophet. Maybe I don't want to offend you; I'll say His servant.

A prophet is a preacher, friends.

Look this way, lady, seem like you got sorrow or something. Yes, it is your husband. He's got arthritis. I see somebody moving. Yes. You believe with all your heart now? Believe God will make you well? You do? Didn't you just have an operation, lady, of the colon or something another? Something in the colon, it was, wasn't it? Uh-huh. It was something taken out, a cancer or something taken from the colon.

L-80 You've had some trouble, haven't you? You had a lot of fight trying to get here or something another. I see you being troubled in the road, haven't you? Believe Him?

Lady, with your hand up, do you believe with all your heart? Uh-huh. That's right. Did you ever find that pocketbook there, you'd lost? You didn't? All right. I hope you find it someday. God bless you. That's truth, isn't it? You see now, be--be--be faithful.

L-81 Now, lady, you believe out there? There's another lady setting here. You're trying to find out something about... You got a loved one that's sick, a mother. That's right. You believe? Have faith. God will heal her. You just believe with all your heart. Believe with all your heart.

Lady there, do you believe with all your heart? She's a Jewish, isn't she? Isn't she? She has cancer of the bone. Isn't that right? And you want to accept her he--healing for her now? You believe that she'll get well? All right, I want you to bow your head and pray.

What's the matter with you people? Don't you see that Jesus Christ is in the room? His power is here to make well. Somebody in here believe. Have faith in God. [\[Mark 11:22\]](#)

L-82 Lady, setting right there with the book in your hand. You're sick. You need healing. You have diabetes. Is that right? Jesus Christ will make you well if you'll just believe it. Amen. Just be praying. Have faith in God.

I--I can't hear you, sister, in here. It's my ears especially, at this time. You see? I know you're talking but I...

That bowel trouble will leave you, little preacher there, if you just have faith in God. And them allergies will soon drive away and you won't be bothered with it no more. Have faith in God. Can you do it? Amen. God bless you.

That lady setting right back there has got heart trouble, right behind the man with his hand up. She wants to be healed. She can be healed too. Do you believe, lady, and believe that God will make you well? You do? All right. Stand up to your feet. [\[Mark 11:22\]](#)

L-83 How many in here wants... How many all over the building wants to be healed? I tell you what you do then. I won't tell you... Now, look. Everybody that wants to be healed, raise your hand way high. I just wanted you to see the Holy Spirit's here.

Now look, everybody with your hands up. Now, look at somebody else that's got their hands up, and--and--and lay your hands over on the person that... Well, lay your hands on one another. Just lay your hands over on somebody near you.

O God, oh, mercy. Over here, lay your hands on each other. All down through there. Somebody... just lay your... Everybody that's got their hand up, somebody lay hands on them. The Bible said, "These signs shall follow them that believe." The preacher? No. Them that believe. "If they lay their hands on the sick, they shall recover." Is that right? [\[Mark 16:18\]](#)

L-84 Now, just in your own simple way, let's just gather down and start praying. And while you're praying, I'm going to ask Jesus Christ our Lord, to curse the devil that's bound you. You believe He will do it? Come here, ministers, and come here and stand here with me.

Everybody look at this scene here. Look what's setting here now. Be reverent everywhere now, real reverent. 'Cause demons will be turning loose here in a few minutes and be a dangerous thing.

O God, be merciful to these people. You see them, Lord, and the deep sincerity; they got their hands laid on each other. And they believe that You're here now. And I'm quoting Your Word tonight, Lord. You said, "These signs shall follow them that believe: If they lay hands on the sick, they shall recover." [\[Mark 16:18\]](#)

L-36 Well then, if--if He's here... But He's working through His Church now; and we're His Church. Then if I'd lay hands upon you, like He commissioned me to do, do you believe that arthritis would all leave you and you would be able to just to stomp your feet around and run home? Do you believe that? Then receive it in the Name of Jesus Christ. May it leave you.

Now, come on. Jump your feet up-and-down. That's right. Now, see, it's all gone. Just go off the...

Let's say, "Thanks be to God."

Would you believe the same way if you were...?... Well, in the Name of Jesus Christ may you receive it and return back to your city rejoicing and being well. Amen. Now, go doing that with all your heart, just being happy and rejoicing and praising the Lord. Amen. [\[Mark 16:18\]](#)

L-37 That's the way friends. You've got to show God your appreciation. You know, if I would do something for somebody and I'd say... I'd have to make a great sacrifice like God did for us. And then, and somebody... I'd have my little check wrote out here to someone, and I--I'd say, "Here you are, brother, for your missions in the foreign fields or something." He'd reach over, "Uh-huh."

I--I--I'd feel kind of bad, wouldn't you? Oh, I'd expect him to say, "Thank you, Brother Branham. I--I

know that really is taking what you got. You see? But I sure appreciate it, Brother Branham."

L-38 And that's the way God wants you to say, "Why, thank You, Father. I come up here to be healed, and it's all explained to me. And You've proven it to me now. So I'm ready to go away from here rejoicing. Praise the Lord." And go away just rejoicing and made well.

That's the way to do it. No matter if He wouldn't say nothing at all, still you should rejoice, because the Word said so first. And that's the initial, is that right, brethren? That's the initial, the Word. All right, bring the lady.

All right. Are you believing with all your heart?

Little lady setting there, you got bowel trouble and rectal trouble, setting right back there. Isn't that right? You was healed just a few minutes ago of that, in your seat. And you--you're setting there; I--I was trying to wait. I tell you a little later on. But I was afraid I'd forget it.

L-39 Now, you go home and that's going to stop. That dysentery and everything is going leave you. And--and it's going to be all right, them hemorrhoids and things will go away and you're going to be all right. God bless you. Have faith. That's your faith now. I never prayed for you. Your faith has saved you. Your faith has made you whole. See, see? You didn't have a prayer card to get in the line or nothing, 'cause there was no way for you to get here. But you just had faith. And God has healed you and made you well. So that--that's just the way He does it. Amen.

How do you do, lady? Do you believe with all your heart? You believe? Well, you believe that Jesus Christ is here to make you whole? You suffer with some sort of a--of a nervous condition. Isn't that right? You're very nervous, upset.

Say, you're not--you're not from Chicago. You're from out... you come from--from--from a way--from the east, coming here. Yes. All right. You believe He's going to send you back well? You believe that? That's right. Now, raise up your hands and say, "Thank You, Lord." Amen. [\[Matthew 9:22\]](#), [\[Mark 5:34\]](#), [\[Mark 10:52\]](#), [\[Luke 8:48\]](#), [\[Luke 17:19\]](#)

L-40 Now, the nervousness is gone from you. You was made well standing right there. Return back to Buffalo, rejoicing and praising God. God bless you, sister. God bless you.

Let's say, "Praise the Lord." [Congregation says, "Praise the Lord."--Ed.] See? Never prayed for the woman, never touched her at all. I seen an airplane rise up. And I looked to the right hand side of the airplane where she looked from, and Niagara Falls was to the right, from where she raised up from. And I knowed she'd come from the east somewhere. 'Cause she was... passed by Niagara Falls. Is that right, lady? All right, sir. That's right. It was in the vision just then. Amen. Hallelujah. Our Lord Jesus cannot fail.

L-41 Are you finished with that old kidney trouble and giving it over to God, and saying, "I'm going home and get well"? Believe it right now? You just go off of the platform, say, "Thank You, Lord Jesus," and be happy. God will bless you and make you well.

Never want to wear glasses, do you? You want to be well from that eye trouble, is that right? And you're nervous and upset and so forth. All right. Believe Jesus healed you right where you're standing? Go, in the Name of Jesus Christ, may the thing go out of you. Amen. Amen.

Let's say, "Praise the Lord." You do the same thing, lady, you have the same thing. Now, go on just rejoicing. Yes, sir. That's exactly. Go off and say, "Praise the Lord." Just go rejoicing, happy, saying, "Blessed be the Name of the Lord." Amen.

L-42 Oh, what we ought to do tonight, we ought to take this place by--not hold the fort but take the fort. Jesus Christ here, the Son of God...

Now look, lady. Here. Come across there. Just let's see you walk like a young lady. Come right on down there. That's the time. Yes, ma'am. That's the way. That's the way I want you to do it. Amen. Praise the Lord.

She'd been bothered so much, nervously too. And...

You're bothered with a nervous condition too, aren't you, setting there on the--the end of the row? No. Your husband, setting next to you. Uh-huh! Yes, sir. You've been in the hospital, haven't you? Spent two or three months over in a hospital, with a nervous breakdown, is that true? All right. You can go home and get well now.

L-43 Lady, you hit that lady. You--you're some... connected with her. Is that right? You have arthritis, don't you, the--the lady in the checked dress? You want to go home and get well too? Well, God bless you just... When the service is over, go down the street, singing: "Glory To His Name." And just... Stand up. That's right, brother. Stand up and give God praise. That's right. Amen.

Say, "Thank the Lord. Thank the Lord for His healing power." Amen.

Our Lord Jesus cannot fail. There's no way for Him to fail. He is the Lord. Amen. Have faith now. Believe with all your heart and God will grant it.

L-44 It keeps moving... Are you two sisters there? And if God just... I... If you'll just have the least bit of faith, lady, you--you'll be healed tonight. See? You won't never use them crutches no more if you just have faith now.

All right, bring the--the lady on. Do you believe with all your heart? All your soul? All your strength?

Excuse me. I--I was... See, I'm glad you said, "Yes." That's very nice. I... That's what I want you to do is say, "Yes." You believe God will make you well? Exactly. You have trouble in your chest too (Isn't that right?), a hurting. You got a lot of troubles too, haven't you? You're now thinking about someone at home. It's... I believe it's a mother. You have a mother. She has a--a--a stroke, I believe it is. Or... Yeah. And you have one that... Have high blood pressure too. That's right.

L-45 Say, by the way, aren't you Catholic by faith? Is that right? I see the beads and things that... Do you believe that God will heal you, and make them well, and you go home happy, rejoicing and... Wouldn't you like to have the--the fullness of God's Spirit, to--to be filled with the Holy Ghost? Wouldn't you like--wouldn't you enjoy that blessing? Do you know it's for you, sister? Jesus Christ died that you might have it. And I pray that you'll receive the Holy Ghost before you leave this meeting. You know what the apostolic way of to receive the Holy Ghost is lay hands on them. And they received the Holy Ghost. And you'll receive it. Do you believe that? Come here just a moment.

L-46 Almighty God, as this woman with her sincerity, standing here, believing that You're going to make her well, I pray that You'll heal her, and all that's connected in this. And may she also receive the baptism of the Holy Ghost, Lord. May she be a testimony in this last days, to give praise and glory to God, in Jesus Christ's Name.

Go off the platform rejoicing, saying, "Thank You, Lord." Amen. That's the way. Amen.

Some clergy ought to get to her immediately. All right, come if you will. All right.

Do you believe with all your heart? Believe that God will make you well? That's wonderful. All right. I want you... Have faith in God and believe with all your heart that God's going to make you well. And that back will just smooth out and you won't have that trouble no more. Is that right? It's gone now. God has took it away from you.

Move yourself down like this and see. See what I mean? Now, you go on off the platform and be happy. Your faith healed you, sister. [\[Mark 11:22\]](#)

L-47 All right, come sir. Uncle, as you come do you believe that Jesus Christ, the Son of God, died to make you well? And He will heal you of that heart trouble if you will ask Him? Do you believe He does it now? Then say, "Praise the Lord." That's right. That's the way to do it. Amen.

Come, sir. That's... Amen. Brother, I'm telling you, colored folks are not ashamed of their religion. I know that from being down in Africa, where--where they come from. Brother, let them see the power of God move once, and you don't have to say no more. They got it and gone. Amen. Oh, shame on us.

Amen.

L-48 Wouldn't a nice big thick hamburger taste good tonight? You haven't had one in a long time. Go on, eat it. God bless you. And may the Lord make...?... Amen. Hallelujah!

Now, if that man could go off the platform, that colored man, rejoicing, healed with heart trouble, you ought to receive the same thing. God bless you. Go on. That's right. Go on and believe with all your heart.

Do you believe, lady? That old arthritis is gone from you. Go on off and show the people what the Lord has done for you. Amen. Amen.

Get away from that heart trouble. Just move on across, saying, "Thank You, Lord. Thank You, Lord," and be made whole. Amen.

Do you believe with all your heart now?

Lord Jesus, bless the woman, and heal her, I pray, in Jesus' Name. Amen. Now, go rejoicing, saying, "Thank You, Lord Jesus. Thank You." All right.

Have faith in God. Amen. I... [\[Mark 11:22\]](#)

L-49 God bless you, lady, setting there. You ain't going to be bothered with that old sinus no more. It-it's done gone from you now. Amen. Amen. God makes you whole, sister. God be with you. Hallelujah.

You want to get over that rheumatism, setting there? You do? Just believe it, raise up; have faith in God and God will make you well. Amen. That's all you have to do.

Sister Wood, I thought that was you. But it isn't. It's the lady setting next to you there. She has a female disorder. And she's nervous, kind of a nervous disposition. Something's happened to her nerves. Isn't that right, lady?

You're having a--kind of a little domestic affair. Isn't that true? Well, God bless you. May He make you completely whole, take everything away, and make you exactly well. God bless you and give you peace.

L-50 Setting right back out there with that sinus, sir. If you want to get well, just raise up and accept it with all your heart. God bless you. He healed you just then. It's all finished now. You can go home. God bless you.

How do you do, lady? Do you believe me as God's servant? All right, I want to talk to you just a minute, being that you're the last one in the prayer line. Do you--you believe with all your heart? All right. Do you believe our Lord Jesus Christ is here in all of His lovely power and...

L-65 This is strange to you, isn't it? And what makes you so upset, you're bothered with nervousness anyhow. That's your trouble. You believe He will take it away from you? It's your age, and this time there's probably only one remedy for you: that's Christ. That's a horrible thing. It's the worst feeling anyone could have. There's nothing like feeling that distressed. You see? But Jesus Christ can make you well.

And remember, there's not a remedy in a doctor's book for it. Why? It's oppression, demon oppression, like a dark shadow hangs, it's always causing you to be that way. But He will heal you if you can believe. Will you believe? Let's bow our heads.

L-66 Lord Jesus, I pray that You'll heal the woman. Let her go from here tonight and be made well. Grant it, everlasting God, in the Name of Thy Son of Jesus. Amen. God bless you, lady. Now, go thanking God, being happy, and God will grant it.

You having faith? Now, remember friends, it's your faith. There's nothing that a man can do to heal you. A Man has already healed you. You just got to believe what He's done for you. See?

You believe, lady? All right. Let's you and I talk just a moment then. If you're a believer, I--I believe that is truth. You have a wonderful atmosphere. But you're suffering. You have--you've had... Your trouble is

bad enough to you as just... you've been to a doctor. And I see him doing something, writing on a... Oh, it's a heart trouble. You have heart trouble, don't you? L-67 Let us say, "Thanks be to God." [Congregation says, "Thanks be to God."--Ed.] Believe with all your heart, you shall see the... Everybody in here ought to believe right now. Everybody in here ought to accept their healing just at this time. Believe with all your heart.

How do you do, laddie. My, I like boys with hair cuts like that. You love the Lord? You do. Well, I think you're a fine boy. And now--and a any boy that loves the Lord and loves his mother and father, and I think that's a good boy. I think he can't go wrong doing that.

Now, what if Jesus was here tonight, and you was standing before him, as you are Brother Branham? Now, Jesus would know just what was wrong with you. Asthmatic cough. Laying down many times, you have to raise; it just coughs you and hurts you so bad. That's a horrible thing. God bless you little boy. You got a very tender spirit.

That's your mother setting right there, isn't it? You believe too? That's your little sister setting right there also. She's got sinus trouble. Isn't that right, honey? Your mother has hay fever. Isn't that right? She has dropsy also. God bless this little lad with his tears running down his cheeks. Let the mother stand and the little girl stand. While the Spirit of God is here tenderly, put your hands over on mother, sister, and mother to the girl.

Our heavenly Father, let Thy mercies come now to these people and may they go from here tonight, and all of them get well. Grant it, Lord. I rebuke the devil that's binding him, may it come out of him in the Name of Jesus Christ. Amen.

Look, little lad, what's your name? Your... See, your asthmatic condition's gone. If all this dust on the floor and things like this, you'd be coughing your head off if you'd catch that. You're healed now. God bless you. Go, and may God be with you.

You believe, sir, if I just ask God and God will heal you. In the Name of Jesus Christ may the healing power of God strike your body and make you well. Amen. Now, go believing with all your heart, saying, "Thank You, Lord Jesus."

L-69 All right. Would come, sir? What do you think? Excuse me. Excuse me. Do you believe with all your heart? Would you like to go home and eat your supper? All right. Go ahead. Jesus Christ will make you well. God bless you. May God bless you. Now, you're going to serve him? All your life? All right. God bless you. All right.

Come, lady. Believe God will heal your eyes and make you well? You do? Will you accept your healing now from Jesus Christ the Son of God? Lord Jesus, I pray that You'll heal her. And stomach trouble? So just go on off, and eat your supper, and praise God and preach the Gospel. Amen.

Let's say, "Praise the Lord." [Congregation says, "Praise the Lord."--Ed.] Amen. Oh, thanks be to the Lord Jesus. My soul cries out and magnifies Him, Who is the Author of my life and your life. He is the Author of Everlasting Life, the Giver of every good gift, and sweet and lovely to those who love Him. No wonder He's so... Oh, I love to pour the adoration of my heart to Him. It's joy unspeakable and full of glory to serve Him. Never do I have a desire for anything else but to serve our Lord Jesus Christ. Amen.

L-71 You want to get over that foot trouble, brother? You do? Stop smoking cigarettes then and serve the Lord, you can have it. Will you do it? All right. God bless you. Go on then, get well. Amen. The blessings of God rest upon you all. Hallelujah.

Something strikes my soul and sways me when I know His Presence is around. Oh, what a feeling. My clothes fit me right, everything, when I know that He's near. You may call me a fanatic. That'll be all right. If it takes fanaticism to believe Jesus Christ, then I'm a fanatic. Amen. I love my Lord. And I know His blessings is with us. And we are the sheep of His fold. Let us come into green pastures and eat to our heart's desire. Amen. Praise the Lord.

Would you come, lady? I know. I--I see what's wrong. Now, you just have faith and just believe there with all your heart.

L-72 How do you do, lady? Yes, that's the colored lady I was speaking to. Just have faith there, brother. Jesus Christ is present now to make you well.

Do you believe? All your heart? Had quite a time getting here, didn't you? A lot of traffic on the road, isn't there? When you got behind that bus, that was terrible, wasn't it? You're awfully nervous, aren't you? Got a lot of temper that causes that nervousness. You're trying to get rid of it. You got a lot of domestic trouble too that's bothering you. Isn't that true. Yes. Your boy back, your daughter, step-daughter left with him. She's got a foul spirit. She went somewhere with him to a country, where they'll see these great trees, big pine trees. It's on a... It's near a lake or a seaside or something another. Say, I'd say Washington or something like that, along in the state of Washington. Is that right? ["Tacoma"] Tacoma. I thought it looked like along that Puget Sound. I... You believe that you'll be healed? You believe that the boy will return. Will you accept Jesus Christ promised that all things work together for good? And you're ready to quieten yourself down and submit yourself to his will? Come here. Let's pray together.

Lord Jesus, be merciful to this woman, and may Thy Spirit come upon her, and may she be made whole, Lord. Give to her the desire of her heart. Grant these kind blessings, our heavenly Father. In the Name of Thy Son, Jesus Christ. Amen. [\[Mark 11:22\]](#)

L-73 Now, go believing. Go, rejoicing, being happy. Now look, lady, if God Almighty can reveal your life here before this audience, He certainly... If He knows what was, He will know what will be. Is that right? Now, don't worry. Worry hasn't got one bit of value to it at all. See? Just what would worry do any good? But faith does do good. So have faith. God bless you.

All right. Come, lady. You believe? You want to get over the asthma? All right, just accept Jesus Christ now as your Healer. With all your heart? Now, what you got on your mind, "Is he going to lay hands on me?" Yes. Come here. All right.

Lord Jesus, You said, "According to your faith..." I pray that You'll heal her now in Jesus Christ's Name. Amen. Now, go out thanking God and get over it and don't bother it any more. [\[Mark 11:22\]](#)

L-74 All right. Have faith in God now. Believe with all your heart and you shall receive all your blessings. Amen. Now I'm not reading the people's mind as some of you thinking out there now. That's wrong.

Here, I'll... Now, this is a man standing here. I've never looked at him. Put your hand on my shoulder, sir. Could God reveal to me what's wrong with you? Want to get over the asthmatic condition too? If you'd... You do. All right. I've never looked you in the face. So I couldn't be reading your mind. You got asthma. You're nervous. Go on off the platform and be well, in Jesus Christ's Name. See? [\[Mark 11:22\]](#)

L-75 It's vision, friend, not reading mind. It's vision. Have faith in God. Believe with all your heart. All right. Come. So nervous, eye condition bothering you, astigmatism. You want God to make you well? He has done it. You believe it? All right. That settles it.

Father, thank You for her faith and may she go from here and not be troubled any more in Jesus Christ's Name. Amen.

Now, go rejoicing, mother, thanking God and you shall receive just exactly what you've ask for. [\[Mark 11:22\]](#)

*Wonderful, wonderful, Jesus is to me,
The counselor, Prince of Peace,
Mighty God is He:
Saving me, keeping me from all sin and shame,
Wonderful is my Redeemer, praise his name!*

L-76 You believe? You believe that arthritis is going to leave you now and you're going off the platform well? Just hobble right on off the platform, stomping your feet up-and-down. Don't--don't give in to it. Go on, that's right. Amen.

You believe Him now with all your heart? All right.

Come. How do you do? You believe? I believe that, mother. Your trouble is in your eyes, isn't it? Cataracts over your eyes. There's something strange about you. Do you believe me as God's servant? I believe that. You're--you're been a traveler, haven't you? You're a missionary, that's what you are. You've been over many waters. Is that true? ["Yes, around the world three times."] Around the world three times? ["...?... all the mission fields."] All the mission fields. God be with you. My sympathy goes for you. And my admiration goes for you.

L-77 You've got some... You're connected with somebody that's an official in a--a school or son-in-law or something, that's--that's... It's Asbury College. That's where it's at. You're a Methodist, aren't you? from Wilmore, Kentucky? Is that right? God bless you.

O God, give this woman her sight. I pray that the cataract will die and this woman will be well. God, bless this old handmaid of Yours, who's traveled the seas. And may she be healed in Jesus Christ's Name. I ask the demon of darkness to never blind these eyes over, that she'll see yet to glorify Jesus Christ. In His Name we ask it. Amen. God bless you, mother. Go on your road rejoicing now and be well. Let's say, "Praise be to God." [Congregation says, "Praise be to God"--Ed.]

All right. Come lady. Hallelujah. What was it? What was hers? What--what--what happened if something another...?... [Someone speaks to Brother Branham--Ed.] Oh... Oh, oh.

L-78 How do you do? You want to get over that old nervous condition and go home and get well, be made whole? You believe God will make you that way? Lord Jesus, may Thy hands of grace and power be laid upon her. May she go from here tonight and be healed sound and well. I pray that her faith will not fail, in Jesus Christ's Name. Amen. Now, go rejoicing now and say, "Thank You, Lord Jesus." That's the...?... Amen.

All right. Come, lady. Do you believe Him with all your heart? Believe that God will make you well? That's the way to believe it.

L-79 Bless be the Lord Jesus Christ. A vision appeared right here. It's somebody that's setting right in here somewhere (I couldn't see the face well.), that's got something wrong with their hands, kind of a--a breaking on their hands. Right--right in here somewhere. I seen somebody had a... was something on

their hands. It's a blood eruption. That's what it is. Blood disease or something that's making a... Setting right in there. Oh, yes. No wonder I... that's... God bless you. All right.

Now, do you want to get over the heart trouble? Go, rejoicing saying, "Thank You, Lord!" and get well. Amen.

Let's say, "Praise the Lord." [Congregation says, "Praise the Lord."--Ed.]

L-80 Now, how do you do, sir. You believe that God will make you well? Get over the heart trouble? And you also are anemia? Is that right? Will you believe that God will make you well? I heard your doctor what he said to you. Go and accept Jesus Christ as your Healer and you shall have it. God bless you, my brother, in Jesus' Name.

Let's say, "Praise be to God." [Congregation says, "Praise be to God."--Ed.] Hallelujah. [Congregation says, "Hallelujah!"--Ed.] Have faith now. Be reverent. Believe with all your heart.

Bring the man. That's kind of a bad place there, isn't it? It's the rug down there. Yes, sir. All right. We are strangers, sir. We are. I don't believe we ever met in life. But God knows us both, doesn't He? Yes, sir, He does. Now, as far as your healing, Jesus Christ has purchased that when He died at Calvary. I'm just His servant, to try to help you to have faith. You understand that, don't you? Yes, sir.

L-81 You're seriously ill, sir. You have been operated on. You was operated on for a gallbladder condition. Yes, sir. Now, that's... look at there at the shots. My. Just hold right here to the side of this... Yes, sir. In the operation, they found something else, didn't they? [A man says, "Found a cancer."--Ed.] Yes, sir. And it was in the--in the intestinal tract. You believe God will heal you of that? You do. If I'll ask Him and you'll believe Him, then he... it'll have to happen, won't it?

Now look, sir, you realize that you just got... The doctor told you six months. Is that right? to live. You know that within a few moons, you're going to pass to the other side. You only have one hope, my brother. [A man says, "I don't care if I can't get well...?..."--Ed.] Certainly. ["I'm ready to go."] But what would you do if He let you live? Testify of Him and glorify Him...?... God bless you. That's the way to be. That's the way, brother. Sir? All right.

Now, let us pray and ask Him. Lord Jesus, the Son of God, as this dying man stands here before me, confessing that he has accepted You as his Saviour. He believes in You. I pray, Father, that You will bless the man and will heal him. And may the doctors be surprised when they look back at him again, saying, "What's happened to you, man?" Then he will give praise and glory to Thee. For we ask it in Jesus Christ's Name. Amen. God bless you, my brother. God bless.

L-82 Say, I want to talk to you just a moment away from the mike. That's right, see? You can stop that? Give it up to God? God bless you. See? God had to reveal that. God bless you. Just go rejoicing.

Let's say, "Praise be to God." [Congregation says, "Praise be to God."--Ed.] Amen. Bless be the tie that binds our hearts in Christian love. You believe with all your heart? Hallelujah.

The Lord bless you, my sister. Only believe. Have faith in God. Got a back trouble that's hurting you there. You just kept holding onto God. You were crying out to Him and praying, believing that God would make you well, having faith. Isn't that right? All right, sir. He--He's heard you. So, don't worry no more now. God's peace be upon you.

Setting there with the stomach trouble, second one in back there, if you want to be healed too, just believe God. God will make you well. Standing right over you now, and a table setting there where it's... I know you're refusing your food. Yes, but... You believe that He makes you well? All right, sir.

L-83 The lady sitting next to you there too? Yes, now You believe that God will make you well. All right. God will be with you. That's right.

Sir, you're for a very just cause. You want to quit smoking and go and be made well and healed of God? You're fixing to leave town tonight, aren't you? fixing to go away. God's here to make you well, and send you away from here rejoicing and happy, if you'll just believe Him with all your heart. You accept Him now as your Deliverer?

Almighty God, may Your Spirit come upon the man. May he go away from here and praise You the rest of his days. God, grant it in Jesus Christ's Name. Amen. Now, go rejoicing saying, "Thank You, Lord." Every person setting in here tonight should be well right now. You believe that, young man, setting there in the wheelchair? You do believe that? Do you believe that, sir, setting over there in the wheelchair? Anybody can see that you all... what's wrong with you. You're crippled. See? It's these people that look well is the things where the mystery comes.

L-84 Little lady, what do you think about it? You believe that Christ will make you well? How many sick people's in here, raise your hand, say, "I believe that Christ will make me well right now."? I want to quote something to you. I want to do it. Anointing's not striking you so hard at this time, 'cause I skipped a few of them through there without saying nothing to them or watching for vision. So I could do this at the end of the line.

There was in the Bible, three lepers set at the gate one time of the city of Samaria. It was besieged by the Syrians. And they were lepers. In the city, they were killing one another's children and eating the children. They'd eat all the bark off the tree and the grass off the ground.

L-85 And these lepers says... Well, the Syrians had them besieged and they was starving them to death. Now, they said, "Why set we here until we die? Now, we got to do something. Now, let's see, there's only two roads." One of them led in the city.

They had three things they could do. They could go into the city when the gates opened again, or they could set where they were, or they could go down to the camp of the Syrians. Well, they said, "If we go into the city, there's no food there, because the people are eating one another's children. So there's no food there. And if we sit here, we're sure to die. So we only got one hope; that is, we'll go down to the Syrians. If they kill us, we're going to die anyhow. We're--we're going to die. So if we go down to the host of the Syrians, if they kill us we die anyhow. But if they save us, then we live." Now, they only had one--one chance, and that was going down to the host of the Syrians. [\[III Kings 7:3-9\]](#)

L-86 Now, what a chance that was: to an enemy, and them lepers. So you're not in that position tonight. But perhaps, you're setting in these chairs, you're got cancer, you--you're eat up with cancer, TB, and so forth. There's not a thing on earth you can do about it. Your doctor has done all he can do. Medical science, everything has done all they can do. And if you're setting there, you're bound to die in that condition.

So, let's do something about it. We got a chance tonight. And that's not go down to the enemy's camp, but come to your lovely heavenly Father Who's promised to heal you. You're going to die anyhow. So let's come and believe His Word.

L-87 He may save you. Not He may, He will. He has. He's just only wanting you to believe it and exercise a little faith. Can you do that? Can you believe tonight for anything? Oh, my brother sister, if you could only take a hold yonder and say, "Yes, Lord Jesus, I believe it." If you believe it deep enough in your heart, there's not enough devils in this country to keep you from being healed tonight. All...

"Heavens and earth will pass away, but God's Word shall never pass away." Is that right? Now, He said, "Whatsoever things you desire..."

I have to watch over the audience. People are being healed setting right along here now. After I'm gone from here weeks. You'll still be hearing the people being healed, saying, "Well, that just left me. That just left me." It's happening all over the building right now. It does each night. I see it like that.

L-88 If I go to looking close to it, then it's just one vision from another. And then I get so weak I can hardly go through the meeting. But let's you and I tonight rise and say, "Lord Jesus, I've--I've set here long enough. I'm coming to You tonight, believing with all my heart that You're going to do it right now for me." Will you believe it?

Now, I tell you what you--want you to do. I want you to bow your head, everywhere. Now, I'm going to

pray for you. And now, if you believe the commission of the Angel? He said, "If you'll be sincere, get the people to believe, nothing shall stand before the prayer."

L-89 Now, look friends, think of King George of England, when he was healed with multiple sclerosis, when we had prayer for him. Think of Florence Nightingale, her grandmother, the founder of the Red Cross, was about sixty pounds of weight, laid dying yonder with a cancer on the duodenal of the stomach, laying there dying. A little dove flew into the bush there and the Spirit of God come and said, "THUS SAITH THE LORD, she shall live." And she weighs a hundred and fifty-five pounds in perfect health.

Think of Congressman Upshaw setting bound in chairs and bed for year after year, for sixty-six years. And right in a moment's time raised to his feet, run through the building, touched his toes, was perfectly made normal and well.

Just think of the thousands and thousands of people that's been healed. Why set we here until we die? Let's do something about it.

L-90 Now, if God would respect a prayer... I'm asking each one, don't pray for yourself, pray for somebody else. Don't pray for yourself. I'm going to pray for you. You pray for somebody else. And then I'm going to ask the devil with one rebuke to leave every person here. I believe anybody that will believe Jesus Christ and accept Him and His resurrected power, will be healed tonight, right here. You can accept it and go home and be well.

I want you to bow your heads. Lord Jesus, I have tried with all my heart, Lord, in these past nights to explain, to bring to the people the love of God, that He had for them when He shed abroad the Holy Spirit in their hearts. They're lovely. They set in this hot building listening every night.

But, Lord, I realize that there's one thing wrong: that Satan keeps making them wonder, "Well, am I sure it could be?" I pray Thee, Lord, that You will bless them and will heal them. And may Your Spirit be upon everyone just now. And may the enemy lose his grip. And may women and men and boys and girls, those who are setting in the building now, with one accord, Lord, look to You as we're praying one for the other.

L-38 Now, the things that you did... Now, if Jesus Christ has risen from the dead... Do you all believe that with one accord? Well, if He has risen from the dead, then He is under obligation to produce His Life in His church. Is that right? That's what He said that these signs shall follow them to the end of the world. Now, see then, He only does what the Father says. Now, may the good Lord of heaven bless us each. [\[Mark 16:15-18\]](#)

L-39 Now, I could heal no one. I could only do as God would show me what to do and what to say. To do this is the prophetic utterance of the Spirit that foresees what will be, what has been, what is now. That's only by grace that God does that.

Now, lady, I just want to talk to you. If you're pretty sick, you can lean right over here. That's--that's all right. You just... I suppose you and I are strangers, are we? We're strangers. Yes, sir. I've never seen you in my life as far as I knew. You might've seen me, but I--I never seen you.

But if we're strangers, well then, there'd have to be some way that we'd know something about each other. Is that right? God could reveal to you if He wanted to about me, or He could reveal to me about you. I...

L-40 If He's here, and is risen from the dead, and I'm declaring it... Now, if--a man can say anything he wants to. Well, if he wants to be truthful, or honest, or what... But that's up between him and God. But if God testifies that that man has told the truth, then God is testifying of His gift according to the Scriptures. You believe that?

You are a Christian. That's right. I was just... Something... I have a way of knowing it, you understand. And you're extremely nervous. You're suffering with a nervous condition. There's something wrong in your chest. Isn't that right? You've had an operation. But that operation was in the--in the, down in the lower parts of--of... It was a--it was a female operation and... Appendicitis, they'd taken your appendix out. Is that true?

L-41 Is that the truth? Only God... Say, another thing, you're not from this--you're not from this city. You're--you're not from this nation. You're from Toronto, Canada. Or somewhere up along in Canada. Aren't you? That's right. You believe now? Come here.

Almighty God, the Author of Life, and this poor sick woman. I pray You to be merciful to her now. And as I lay these my unworthy hands upon her, it's only in commemoration of Your Word, Lord, that I do this. And I ask that we take the initiative side just now. I in faith and she in faith, we come to meet You in prayer. And I say to the evil one that's bound her body, in the Name of Jesus Christ come out of the woman and leave. And may the God of heaven set her free. Amen.

L-42 Now, sister, ever what He said was true. That part, whatever it was, that was right, wasn't it? Now, do you believe me if I'd say what the future would be? You'd have a right to believe. Is that right? Now, right now, of course you're nervous because it's been an upset and just along that time of life, what's making you be nervous like that. But you go on and be happy. Don't even pay any attention to it at all. Just give God praise, and you're going to get well. God bless you.

Let's say, "Thanks be to God."

L-43 Every one bow your head just a minute. Lord Jesus, I ask in Thy Name to bless this woman and heal her. May she go from here tonight, rejoicing, happy, praising You. For I ask it in Jesus Christ's Name. May the enemy turn her loose. Amen.

Now, sister, feel all right now? You're all right. God has healed you. Hear me all right? Just go on off the platform. Hearing comes to...?...

L-44 Do you believe that Jesus Christ the Son of God has risen from the dead, and stands somewhere in this building, the unseen Guest here tonight? But He's manifesting Hissself to let the people know that He's here. Is that right?

Well now, if He'd manifest Hissself to you, then He would--He would be able to tell you... He would know in your mind what you were thinking about. Is that right? Cause He'd know their thoughts. Is that the truth? So then He could reveal to me what your trouble is. And if He would, would that be enough a vindication for you to except your healing?

Now, you're going farther away from me all the time. But you're standing near a table. And you're refusing food. Yes, you have stomach troubles. Is that the truth? Go on now and eat. God bless you. Believe with all your heart and you shall have what you ask.

L-45 How do you do? Do you believe with all your heart, soul, and mind? You believe that the Lord Jesus Christ is present to make you well? We're strangers to each other. Would you like to get over the heart trouble? May God heal you. You believe it? All right. Just go on believe that...?...

Let us say, "Praise be to God."

L-46 Do you believe me with all your heart? Believe that God makes you well? Believe He will make you... If I don't say one word, yet you're going to except your healing. Is that right?

Lord Jesus, I pray that You'll bless the woman. May she go from here tonight rejoicing and happy, in Jesus Christ's Name. Amen. Now, go being happy, thanking God, and you'll get well. Let's say, "Praise the Lord."

Oh, everyone just believe. What more... If--if nothing else was said tonight, Jesus Christ will...

L-47 You two are together, aren't you, setting there in the pink dresses? See? You're praying. You were asking God to let me see you. I did. And you're not from this city either. You're from a country where it

gets real cold in the wintertime. There's lots of geese comes over the country; I see them on the lakes. Isn't it--it's a great building, I see, rising behind you. Why it's--it's Mayo's Clinic. You're--you're from Rochester. Is that right? Is that the truth?

You suffer with arthritis. You suffer with a weakness. Is that right? You don't have prayer cards, do you? Neither one of you have prayer cards? Well, you wouldn't be called up. You just go on home. Jesus Christ has healed you.

Have faith in God. You're bound to know that a supernatural Being is in the building. And that's the Lord Jesus Christ in His power to make well.

L-48 Sonny boy, do you believe that Jesus Christ, the Son of God, is present now? Do you believe Brother Branham to be His humble servant? Do you do that? Would you like to get over that asthmatic condition? You believe God will make you well? Well, let me pray for you. Lord Jesus, heal this little boy. And may he go from here tonight and be made well in Jesus' Name I ask it. Amen. Now, go thanking God, sonny boy, and be made well.

L-49 How do you do, sister? Now, look, you were setting right there on the end of that seat awhile ago. And when I was speaking about Simeon coming into the temple, you let out a great big shout. Is that right? You been... What you've been suffering with left you right then. Now, you go eat what you want to, 'cause your stomach trouble left you setting right there.

Let's say, "Praise the Lord."

You believe He will make you well? Then go home and be made well...?... Let's say, "Praise be to God." God bless you...?...

L-50 In the Name of Jesus Christ, may you go and be made well. All right. Let's say, "Thanks be to God!" The lady that just was shouting, when she was setting there she was healed even before the meeting began. When before... See? Now, she's going to be all right...?...

Now, just have faith. Every one in here can be made well at one time, if you just believe. The Holy Spirit struck the woman; she believed just what I was talking about, when I said, "The Holy Spirit is here tonight, and led you here for a purpose." And that's what God has done. Do you believe that?

L-51 He's here for the entire audience, to bless each one of you, and to give you the desire of your heart. You just have to believe. Have faith. God will bring it to pass.

All right. Bring the lady. How do you do, sister? You believe that the Lord Jesus Christ is present to make well the needy? Do you believe that all the evangelical doctrine of the Bible?

You got several things wrong with you. Since a child, you been a little nearsighted. When you was reading, your--or papers when you was a little girl, you'd hold them close to you. You always do that. Is that right? When you was at school, you did. You also suffer with cancer. That cancer is on the right breast. Is that right? And you're a stranger here. You come from Des Moines, Iowa. Is that right? Now, go back and get well in Jesus Christ's Name.

Let's say, "Thanks be to God."

L-52 Are you believing, lady? My. You believe that He will make you well? Your eyes are going bad. Your... That's--that's getting worse all the time. You're have a heart trouble. Now, Jesus Christ has made you whole. Go on off the platform. Go believing God, giving God praise.

Come, bring...?... How do you do, lady? Do you believe with all your heart? When I said heart trouble to that lady, you had a real funny feeling. All right. Go on. God bless you...?...

Let's--let's say, "Thanks be to God."

L-53 How do you do, sister? You believe with all your heart? You do. Now, you're a very nervous person. See? Not in a nervous of shaking and jumping. But what you're nervous at, it's a mental nervousness, because you are a deep thinker. You're always thinking and taking other people's troubles. You cross bridges 'fore you get to it. Isn't that right? That's the old expression. That's your nature, your make-up.

What your trouble is, you got stomach trouble. And that's just exactly what caused it. It's ulcerated stomach, caused from a nervous condition. Causes souring, and belching, and everything (Is that right?), floaty feeling, and never--smothering when you lay down, and think you have heart trouble sometimes. But it isn't heart trouble. It's just--it's just excess gas going up that tube to your heart. You believe you're healed? God bless you. Your faith...?...

Let's say "Thanks be to God."

L-54 Do you believe, lady, with all your heart? Would you like to be able to walk around again, get that old arthritis out of you? Go on off the platform, accepting Jesus Christ...?... Praise the Lord.

How do you do, lady? You're worried about your eyes and what's going to happen to them. Jesus Christ is your sight. He--He is the Light of the world. Do you believe that? Go, receive your sight in the Name of the Lord Jesus. Your sister, may she receive her healing in Jesus' Name. Amen. God bless you. Let's say, "Thanks be to God."

L-55 You believe sister? You like to get over that old stiffness too, wouldn't you, and be made well again? Lord Jesus, I pray that You'll grant it to the woman in Jesus Christ's Name. Amen. Go rejoicing saying, "Thank you, Lord Jesus."

You was just healed wasn't you? Thanks be to God. You believe your heart trouble has left you? Go--go home and be well.

Howdy do? Back's been bothering you a long time. Just go on off the platform and accept your healing in Jesus Christ's Name. Have faith now. Believe it.

Howdy do? Want to get over your eye condition? Just go accept Jesus Christ as your Healer; He will give you your sight. Now, have... Just believe God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind.

L-56 Lady, you got a... There's your handkerchief in your hand there. You was praying, wasn't you? He heard it. You prayed 'fore you come here. You asked for a condition, something wrong with one of your eyes. You've got a tumor behind the right eye. Is that right? You're suffer with some kind of stiffness too. Isn't that right? All right. You can go home and get well now. In Jesus... You didn't have a card, did you? You didn't have a prayer card? No prayer card. All right. Go ahead. That's all right. All right.

Come, lady. Oh, the Lord Jesus Christ is wonderful, His--His resurrection, His power. The Pharisees couldn't understand. They... What they could see... He knew their thoughts. He knew what they were doing. He only could know as the Father showed Him. And what the Father showed Him, they seen was perfect every time. So they couldn't understand that. And why wasn't He getting the people healed. They said, "Well, He's Beelzebub. He casts out devils by the prince of the devils."

And what did Jesus turn and say? "If Satan cast out Satan, his kingdom's divided." Satan can't cast out Satan. Certainly not. Only God can cast out Satan. How can a strong man enter another's house...

L-57 Now, many times I--sometimes just speak one thing or something another wrong with the people. Maybe that's all there is wrong. Maybe there's others. But what the purpose is, is to try to get to see what all is going on with the peoples, to get you to believe. The main purpose that God is doing, is to try to get you to believe His Son, Christ Jesus died, and raised from the dead, and is living among you tonight, just the same as He was standing here visible, like you see me or some of these other people.

If you can do that. Oh, that settles it. See? These people... The reason... When that little shock comes, that they know we're strangers... I didn't know what they did when they were little girls and boys. And well, how do I know? But mark it, how it happened. See?

L-58 What does it do? I don't know what their future will be. But watch what He says. Pick it up on a tape and see what He says about it. Then you'll... Watch just exactly what He says. That's just exactly what it will be, and Just exactly. Go anywhere in the world where its ever been in the years and years (since a baby), and see if it's ever failed one time. There's dozens of people setting here tonight. I--I don't say a dozen. But there's several setting here tonight from Jeffersonville, from my home tabernacle.

Many people has been through Jeffersonville, and ask the--the officials of the city, or anything you want to, and see if it ever failed one time.

Jesus Christ cannot fail. Heavens and earth will pass away, but His Word can't pass away. Now, this is His Word initially and right. That's His Word. [Brother Branham knocked on pulpit.--Ed.] But if He would speak anything through me, it would be secondarily. But it would still be His Word.

But if what He'd say through me, or any other man, or any other person, it would be secondarily. If it didn't compare with this Word here. It's not right. That's right. This is the foundation. So it's nothing mythical. It's just truth.

L-59 You believe that, lady? My, lady, you really suffer, terrible condition. You have many things wrong with you: complications, just many things. The first thing, your eyes, one of them's about gone, the other one cataracts. And you also... You have a... The doctors just don't know what to do with you. Is that the truth?

I see a doctor, a little short fellow, shake his head and walk away from you. You got a--a floating kidney. For one thing. You got a collapsed colon. Is that right? That's what He told you. I... Just a minute, I didn't get what He said. And you've got a--a--a dropped stomach, asthmatic, arthritis, Is that right? Well, Jesus Christ is here to make you well right now if you'll accept it. Do you believe that?

Lord God, I bless the woman in the Name of Thy Son Jesus Christ, that the doctor can't do nothing working on one they hurt the other, but, Lord, Thou can. Heal her in Jesus' Name. May the Lord bless you, sister.

L-60 All right. Come, sister, Believe with all your heart? You have something that makes people fear. It's a nervousness, just that time of life. Jesus Christ make you whole. Go on, rejoicing, happy, saying, "Praise You, Lord Jesus."

Howdy do, lady? 'Course a woman of your age would have many things. The worst thing, and what you want me to pray for you for is arthritis. Isn't that right? Jesus, I pray that You'll heal her Lord, and may she get up and walk this platform, and go and live the rest of her days happy and healthy, in Jesus' Name. Amen. Now, go...?... Go, say, "Thank you, Lord." That's right. Amen. All right.

L-61 Now, you believe with all your heart? Believe that Christ will make you well? Lord God, bless this woman who I bless in Thy Name. May she go from here tonight happy rejoicing and be made completely whole. In Jesus Christ's Name. Amen. Now, go on rejoicing, saying, "Thank you, Lord Jesus."

All right. You believe, lady, as you come? You believe you were healed setting there? So do I. Amen. Believe it.

All right. Come, lady. You believe with all your heart? Believe that Jesus Christ can heal you? If I don't say a thing about it... When you jumped then your back trouble left you. So just go on...?...

Are you a believer? Will you obey me as God's servant? If I'll tell you what's wrong with you, then you know that God speaks. Is that right? You got arthritis. Is that right? Now, raise your hands up. Say "Thank you, Lord." Stomp your feet up and down. Say, "It's gone from me." Now, go off the platform rejoicing. For it's Christ that's healed you.

L-62 Now, brother you had the same thing. Raise up your hands and say "Praise God, the arthritis is gone." That's right. Rejoicing. All right. Raise up your hands and say, "Thank you, Lord Jesus, for healing me." Lord Jesus, heal him I pray in Jesus' Name.

Let's say "Praise be to God." Amen...?... God, we praise You. Oh, He's real if you'll just believe Him to be real. Is that right?

Young man, I'm looking to you. If you'll just raise your faith. 'Course anyone sees what's wrong, see your paralyzed condition. But my heart goes for you. I got a boy standing right down there in the prayer line, standing there giving out, or bringing the people up on the platform about your age. I want you to be healed, son. I can't heal you. I wished I could. If I could, I'd come right off the platform and do it. But if you'll just let your faith rise up to Jesus Christ there, you'd get up and walk away from that wheelchair.

See? That's right. You believe it, mother? You believe with all your heart? Now, keep--keep faith. Don't--don't try to push yourself. Just simply believe. And what He tells me, I'll tell you. Amen.

L-63 How do you do, lady? Have faith in God. Believe that God is here.

Little lady there from Charlotte, South Carolina. Have faith in God. That sight will all clear up. You'll get all right. Just go on believe Him.

Howdy do? You're the patient, are you. Excuse me. Sometimes visions upsets me as now. Been having headaches for a long time haven't you, lady, about thirty years or more? Do you believe me, that I'm telling the truth about Jesus Christ? You have something wrong with your ears also, and with your eyes. Is that right? Say, you're from out of town also. You come from Texas. Is that right? You believe that? The Spirit of God... And say, there's another thing; you've been--you've been out of the country. You've been across the seas. You're a missionary, with your husband. Yes. You all had been somewhere where they... I believe it's--it's either Czechoslovakia or Germany one. Is--is--is that right? Is that true? And weren't you a Baptist? That's right. Go on home. You're going to get well. In the Name of Jesus Christ...?... [\[Mark 11:22\]](#)

L-64 You want to get over that stomach trouble? Then go eat your supper in Jesus' Name.

You believe, lady? You want to get over that female condition? It's a abscess. Go, believe Jesus Christ will make you well.

Let's say "Praise the Lord." Have faith in God. Don't doubt. Believe.

Lady, do you believe with all your heart? You want get over that heart trouble? You accept your healing in the Name of the Lord Jesus and be made well.

Young lady, do you believe that your eyes will get well now as it is. Amen. Then go and receive your healing in the Name of the Lord Jesus. Amen.

The little colored lady, setting there fanning, you don't have a prayer card do you, lady? setting right here with the fan here? You don't have a prayer card. No. I seen something. Say, you've got a trouble in your side, haven't you? Isn't that right? He healed you just then, so you can...?... you can be healed. See? Have faith in God. [\[Mark 11:22\]](#)

L-65 You believe with all your heart? That little lady setting there with the handkerchief on her, she's got a leaking heart. Isn't that right, lady? All right, sir. You believe Jesus healed you just then when I spoke to you. All right. You can go home and get well too. Have faith in God.

Awhile ago you had a great serious shock. You thought something happened to you. I believe that's when it happened. Amen. Believe with all your heart. God will make you well. Can't you believe that? [\[Mark 11:22\]](#)

L-66 You got intestinal trouble, setting right back there, haven't you, lady? the third one going in that row right there? Isn't that right? You was healed right then of a colitis condition. God made you well. Amen.

Oh, it's all over the audience. Anybody can be healed.

All right, are you the patient? You believe what you see to be the truth? With all your heart you accept it? You're suffering of a terrible nervousness, aren't you? Very nervous. You've had a lot of worry, haven't you? You're studying now about somebody. It's a... It must be a... it's a brother. You've played with him, up... And he's--he's a alcoholic, a drinker. Is that right? Go, and may God heal you and save his life.

L-67 Are you ready to receive Jesus Christ? Do you believe with all your heart? If you believe with all your heart, obey me as God's prophet in His service. Stand up to your feet and say, "Jesus Christ, I believe You and accept You as my Healer right now." While I pray for these handkerchiefs. Lord Jesus, bless these, and I pray that You'll grant it, in Jesus Christ's Name. Amen.

All right. Raise your hands to God. Raise your hearts to God. Believe with all your heart.

Now, Christians, the Holy Spirit of God that fell on the day of Pentecost, is over you. His Spirit is here to heal you. Now, have faith in God, while I ask God to make the fear and doubt leave your mind, God is under obligation to do it. [\[Mark 11:22\]](#)
