L-64 Now, the Bible said, now let's see, "As the days of Sodom," let's hold on that. Usually it's touch His garment. Let's a--let's think this, "Lord tonight for the sick people, let's take it as the days of Sodom, the Angel of God, that was in that flesh gave a sign of Abraham that the time was at hand, if the Sodom, the world was going to be destroyed." How many remembers the story? Sure you do in Genesis.

Now, Jesus, over in the New Testament, said, "Just before the end time, the coming of the Son of man, that same thing would re-occur. As it was at Sodom, so shall it be at the coming of the Son of Man." See? [\[Luke 17:29-30\]](#)

L-65 Now, I want you sick people, out there... Now, I do know there's somebody setting here tonight that I know. That's Brother Williams setting right here. And--and these three fellows setting right here, I know them. These three men from Arkansas, and right in here. These three man. Outside of that, Brother Gene Goad setting here, which him and Brother Leo are my associates. But out in there, as far as I could see, it's hard. Any of these ministers will tell you, that to even recognize anybody out in there (See?) from here. But let's pray, and let's just ask the Lord if He will help us, and let His mercy be upon us.

Now, the prayer cards, we don't have any of them, because they're... We taken them up, and they don't--we don't--and give out... And Friday night is going to be the prayer line again for everyone. We're going to give out a whole group of prayer cards. Anybody that wants them, bring them right across the line like we did the other night. See? Therefore, we get everybody prayed for. But now, you don't need that prayer card. You don't need it. The only thing you need to do is have faith that I've told you the truth.

L-66 God--when He said at Samaria, when this woman received this sign, what they going to do, if they didn't believe it? What's the Jews going to do when Nathanael said, "You're the Son of God, the King of Israel."

He said, "Because I told you where you were at? Or told Peter who he was and so forth, you believe?" See? "Then you'll see greater things than this."

And you people who will believe His message, and His Spirit today, will see a greater thing, 'cause you'll see a resurrection someday, and will see the Lord Jesus. [\[John 1:49-50\]](#)

L-67 Now, I'm going to turn my back to you, while you pray. I going to talk to Brother duPlessis. I just want--that's all right, you're...?... You have a nice meeting up there today.

Looking at Brother McAnally setting back here. A--old friend. There--I'm... And as you as ministers I want you to pray for... Right now. You watch. Somebody in this audience is coming in contact with the Holy Spirit, behind me. Back in here. That you might know... Now, I want every sick person to be praying. Every one of you, sick, praying. Now, I can... I feel, in my own make-up that the Holy Spirit, somebody is touching Him. Yeah, there's plenty of them now.

L-68 There's a woman setting in this direction, right here, over here, that just contacted the Holy Spirit. She's suffering with a heart trouble. She's setting right down there. She's having trouble with taking salt in her food and things. You believe with all you heart, lady? Stand up. That's true isn't it? Now, it's all over now. You can go home, be well. Tell me what she touched? What did she touch? The Holy Spirit. Do you believe now? If thou canst believe.

I'll turn my back again to the audience. You pray. See, see brother, you don't have to be looking at people.

Standing here now, I see a woman; she's praying. She is wearing glasses, and she's praying for her eyes. Yes, 'cause they're getting dim. Here she is setting right here. Right back in here, glasses on. She's been healed once before in my meetings. That's right. That is right. Now, you... That's true what's she was praying about. All right. Now, you can go home, believe with all your heart, and be made well.

L-69 Now, I look in this direction. There's a man setting here praying, but it isn't that man. There's another man standing up here before me... He doesn't. If I can see him, he's got a bronchial trouble in his throat. He's setting way back there in the back, kind of a reddish looking shirt on, a praying. There sir. Now, you believe on the Lord Jesus Christ now? You should. All right, you can go home, and be well now, sir. Your faith makes you well. Have faith in God.

That lady setting right down here, has had the same thing, bronchial trouble and so forth too, setting there. Mrs. Metsine or something like? You want... you believe? That's your name. All right, stand up on your feet. I don't know you, do I? That's right. If that's who you are, there's your trouble. Your faith has made you well. Go home.

L-70 You believe with all your heart? What about somebody back in this way now? You pray. Father, this is You--has to be You, 'cause the Angel of the Lord, He had his back turned to the tent. Let it be known that You're still the same God, that they can touch You, just--You know all things. I'm looking at a man, and he's--looks to me like he's Spanish. And he's got something wrong with his side; he got a poison in his body that he got from a work that he's doing. He's also--he's got a message on his heart or something on his heart. He wants to preach. His sympathy is for the sick and afflicted, especially on hospitals. His name is Mister Lee. If you'll believe with all your heart, Mr. Lee, there you are. Jesus Christ gives you what you ask for. See, See? I do not know you. Is that right, sir? I'm a stranger to you. That's right. Go, receive what you ask for now. Jesus Christ makes you well.

L-71 Around the building, do you believe His Presence is here? You believe the Angel of the Lord? Now, there's the Word, there's the promise; there's a reaction of it; there's a promise fulfilled. Now, how many wants to get saved and filled with the Holy Ghost? Come stand here, just a minute now. If you really interested and want the Holy Ghost, and want to be saved, come up here now, and stand around the altar. God bless you. Come on up. If you want to come, I don't care who you are, just come up here. This is the time to get things right. Then we'll have prayer for the sick, the rest of them just the same, but I felt checked by the Spirit, that's enough. If it was these three, wasn't it... Oh, it was more than three wasn't it? Three's a confirmation. That's the way I like to see people come, with no altar call, you know, no--no singing or nothing, just rise up and say, "I'm a--I'm aware that God is present. I come. I come because I--I'm aware of God's Presence. I want to be right. I--I'm going to be asked for a reason someday, and I'm coming now to confess my faith in God, and believe that I'm going to receive it, right now."

L-72 Don't doubt. Don't have a doubt now, if you doubt one bit that you're not going to receive what you come for, it won't do you one bit of good. See? You've got to come believing. But right now, in the Presence of God, in the Presence of the Holy Ghost, that's here to confirm the Word, come because that you know He's here, and you know that He will give you the desire of your heart. That's what He's here for is to give the desire of your heart. Will you come? That's good. That's fine. That's right. I'm going to wait just a second longer to see what the Holy Spirit would do, whatever He would call. See? It seems to me, friend, if you were here with one speck of doubt...

Now remember, I'm going to look at you, and you're going to look at me one day for the last time. And the next time you see me, and I see you, will be in the Presence of God, then there'll never be another chance. You only get one; that's this. And if you've got one speck of doubt about your experience, or if you're not a Christian at all, or you're doubting your experience, why don't you come now. See? If a

enemy, like I spoke on last night, the too many voices, if the enemy's trying to say, "You're too tired, oh, I won't get it." Tell him he's a liar. Tell him that you're going to get it tonight: "And I'm coming and go to-- I'm going to determine I'm going to get it tonight." That's the way to do it.

L-73 Now, how many full gospel ministers are here, or a Presbyterian, Baptist, whatever you may be, that believes that people can receive the baptism of the Holy Ghost today, as well as they did back there, and the prescription is for them? Raise up your hand, Ministers. I know you're interested in souls. Come stand along here with them now, that you might help lay hands on them. Come right up. Stand right along in there and lay hands on them. That's good.

Now, what did I tell you? Is there no balm in Gilead? Sure. Is there no physician there? Look at the physicians coming. These physicians of the Word, they certainly believe it. Look at them. Isn't that wonderful? Look at the ministers, here in this little crowd of people, of three or four hundred people here tonight, look at the ministers: Twenty, thirty, forty ministers standing here, Ministers who believe it. Now, you--you doctors of the Scriptures, do you write--you prescribe the prescription that was give on the day of Pentecost? Do you prescribe that? Sure, it's a double cure, double cure.

L-74 Oh, in the hour of your death, in the hour of your death, how you long to hear that.

Let the water and the blood,

From Thy flowing wounds supply,

Be for sin a double cure,

Safe from wrath and make me pure.

You're here to die now. The only way you can be borned again is to die first, so that you can be borned again. We're going to offer prayer for you...?...

L-75 Now, our heavenly Father, I bring these people sweetly, and humbly to You in the Name of Your Son, the Lord Jesus, to be sure that my prayer is offered for them. To be sure that I have did all that I know how to do, that they will receive You, being that You have been so good to take these old, frail bodies of ours, and to let the Holy Spirit speak through them, it certainly taking a sanctifying grace of God to do it, because we are sinners, and of no good at all. But the Holy Spirit has taken the Blood of Jesus and cleansed our hearts, and sanctified our lips like You did the prophet at the altar. So that you'll see it's not psychology reading your mind, I'll turn my back to you. How about up in this section? This was done once in the Angelus Temple, sister. Brother David, you remember. I'm just... So that you'll see, I'm talking to you, that shows that I have no contact with people there. Surely you--you under... I know you understand. See? But I'm asking the grace of God to do something that the people might know.

L-79 Yes, I see a young person, young girl. She's from away from here; she isn't from this country. She's from a country that's rainy and got a lot of trees and moss; she's from Oregon. She's got epileptic fits. She sets out there. Do you believe that Jesus Christ will make you well? Do you accept it for her? Stand up, sister. Go home, and I rebuke the devil. Do you believe with all your heart? All right.

L-80 In the center aisle here, someone have faith. Don't doubt. I'll talk to you, Brother Schultz, so that you can see that I'm talking to you. I'm letting someone there... There's no prayer cards, so it's just--it's just simply not to bring anyone up, but that they might see.

Yes, there's a thin-like woman; she's got cancer. She was due at the hospital today. She's setting in the front here, kind of a thin woman. Her name is Miss Peterson. See? All right, lady, have faith in God. May the God of heaven kill that devil till it won't even be seen by no one else. Do you believe on the Son of God? You believe Him with all your heart? Just have faith in Him; that's all you have to do.

L-81 All right. You all ready to believe over this a-way? Let me talk to this minister here. Do you believe with all your heart? I hope somebody over there does too. That you might know that I'm talking to you. But, see, the power of God overshadows all mental things, goes into the spirit of realm--realm of spirit. Yes, behind me is a--a woman, and she doesn't know what's the matter with her. She is a... Oh, that poor woman, she's had one, two, three, four, five operations. They don't know what it is. The doctors don't know what it is. She's been sent here to Arizona for a rest. She's from Louisiana, her name is Mrs. Pearson. All right, Mrs. Pearson, somewhere behind me, raise up, look at me. Do you believe me to be God's prophet? I don't know you. If that's right, wave your hand. We--we're strangers to one another. What was said is true. Is that right? The doctors don't know what's the matter with you. It's your nerves. Get real quiet, have faith, and you'll go home well. Have faith in God. Do you believe the Son of God raised again?

L-82 Now, what about somebody in this section? You all ready to believe back here? Pat, are you glad you're a Christian? Isn't it wonderful to get out of the life that you was living and be a Christian?

Here's a lady. It's a woman, a man, and a child. The lady is contacting God. She's behind me. And she's got some sort of a stomach trouble, and she's--she has a weakness afterwards. She's not from here either; she's from a desert-like country, but she's from Kansas. Her husband is a minister. That's her setting right there. I don't know you. If that's right, lady, wave your hands like this. All right, sir. All right, go home; believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and get well. You believe on the Lord?

L-83 All around the building now, do you believe on the Lord? Sure, He's here: Jesus Christ, the same yesterday, today, and forever. The same God Who could show Elijah where that widow woman was; the same God can show me where you're at, setting praying, because it's the Spirit of Jesus Christ, the same yesterday, today, and forever. Do you believe it? Then every person in here put your hands on one another while I pray for you generally right here, and believe, so that you'll know that you've got

something in it, each one of you. You are believers, aren't you? If you are, say "Amen." [Congregation says, "Amen!"--Ed.] In the Presence of God, in the infallible proof of the resurrection of Jesus Christ, put your hands on one another and pray for one another.

L-84 Our heavenly Father, I give to You this waiting audience. May all these people who's repented of their sins find a good church home. May those, Lord, who are sick be healed. May the power of Satan be broken, over their lives right now, as I rebuke the devil and ask that the power of Jesus Christ will come upon this audience and take every sickness, every disease, every affliction, every doubt, drive it from them, Lord, and heal them.
